AffiliationQuebec leader, Allen Nutik, called Quebec Premier Jean Charest "a hypocrite" for accusing ADQ leader Mario Dumont of wanting to isolate Quebec by closing the door to immigration.

"People are still leaving Quebec", emphasized Nutik, "Six hundred thousand plus emigres and their future progeny were not enough to teach Quebec's leadership anything", added Nutik, "and all too few new immigrants are coming this province with its official restrictions on language, education, and access for immigrants and minorities".

"As the head of a government that oversees restrictions that isolate Quebec, Charest claims he wants an open and booming Quebec".

"It's a real oxymoron", scoffs Nutik, who last week insisted that all federal and Quebec political leaders clarify and clearly state their positions on the status of Quebec minority cultural communities, Anglos, and Aboriginal Peoples.

"It's a good time for all leaders to go on record before the upcoming Federal and Quebec bye-elections in September". says the leader of AffiliationQuebec, a new Quebec provincial political party formed to pursue the the full rights and interests of staunch Canadians living in Quebec.

The latest statements by Premier Charest, Intergovernmental Minister Pelletier, and Opposition leader Dumont underscore the valid reasons for the creation of AffiliationQuebec, and serve to remind minority Quebecers of the urgency for them to secure 'new representation' in the Quebec Legislature.
